In number we will continue to explore the properties of number and place value.

We will be exploring the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

We will continue to practise our skills in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

In calculation we will be applying our knowledge of the four operations to solving word problems.

In science we will be tending to our flowers and vegetables. We will also be studying health and growth.
