News



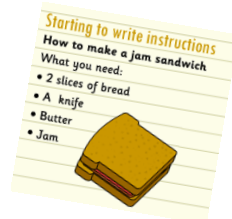

We will also be writing non-chronological reports.

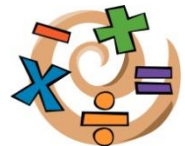


Maths
